- Teams must have 1-2 representatives. At least one representative must be present at each league meeting. Representatives are not required to pay the league's individual player fee (\$70).
- Teams must be sponsored and a \$350 sponsor fee is required to register a team. Many teams partner with local restaurants or businesses.
- Teams must have a name. Teams are most often named after their sponsors (ex. Doughboy Donuts, Midway, etc.).
- A minimum of 12 players is required to register a team. The league fee for individual players is \$70. This fee is non-refundable and must be submitted for each player on the roster when you submit the registration paperwork. *Ex. A team that submits a roster with 12 players (not including team reps) owes $(\$70 \times 12 = \$840) + \$350 = \1190 .*
- At least 50% of all rostered players must be 21 years of age or older by December 31 of the season.
- Each player must also register with Mass Soccer (\$25), <https://reg.mass-soccer.org/accounts/login/?next=/reg/front> (memberships are good for 2 yrs.).
- New teams must register by the first registration period. There are two registration periods before the start of the season. The league Registrar will provide you with a roster template, which you must submit on the designated day along with the appropriate amount of player fees and the sponsor fee. *Please refer to the league bylaws for additional information about how to add/drop players after the two initial registration periods.*
- Teams must secure a home field (teams can share fields). A "Certificate of Insurance" may be required to secure a field, which the league will provide. It is the responsibility of the team to ensure that their home field is lined and mowed according to league standards.
- The league will provide equipment for each team before the start of the season including balls, pumps, nets, corner flags, and paint.
- Teams must wear matching jerseys and socks. Black shorts are required (shorts must be primarily black in color). Team jersey and sock colors must not conflict with existing teams.
- Games are Tuesday and Thursday evenings at 6:30pm and teams must present the referees with an updated roster (this may be printed from the Mass Soccer website or provided by the Registrar). The roster must include players' jersey numbers (they can be hand-written).
